

## Qualifications and Instructions for USI Continuing Scholarship 2011-2012

1. Applicants must enroll in an institution of higher learning.
2. Applicants need not have received a USI scholarship the year they graduated from YUHSD, but must be a YUHSD graduate.
3. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.
4. Continuing USI applications should be **postmarked on or before September 9, 2011** and mailed to:

5. Applicants must provide Official Transcripts of ALL undergraduate college work since high school with the completed application. Unofficial transcripts generated by a computer will NOT be accepted.
6. The applicant must submit a FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA). As a result, he/she will receive a STUDENT AID REPORT (SAR). We need only the page in the report which gives the EXPECTED FAMILY CONTRIBUTION (EFC). We cannot consider your application without this EFC number!
7. The USI continuing application must be **postmarked** no later than **September 9, 2011**. It must contain the following documents:
  - a) Copy of the page of the SAR where the EFC number is reported
  - b) USI Continuing Scholarship Application for 2011-2012 (this form)
  - c) Official Transcript(s) of all undergraduate work attempted and completed since high school
  - d) Proof of enrollment for the Fall Term of 2011-2012
8. Applicants will be notified by Thanksgiving if they are to receive a USI Continuing Scholarship. Proof of enrollment for Fall Term 2011-2012 must be enclosed with the application or be mailed to United Scholarships, Inc. before an award can be paid!
